and to Zoo School BASIC Graduates (1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grades only)**

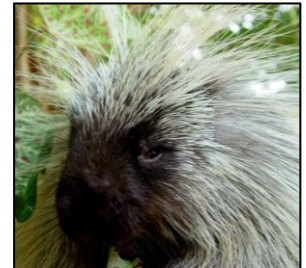
**Zoo School ADVANCED** is a **NEW** 12-week series of advanced hands-on zoology enrichment classes for all 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students who love animals and our environment and for 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade students who have already graduated from Zoo School BASIC (graduates still in Kindergarten will have to wait one more year). This class will be offered Spring semester 2011 as an after school elective. As always, each 45-minute class will feature a combination of lecture, discussion and live demonstration animals. Each student is provided with follow-along student packets and take-home exercises. Students will also complete a semester-long independent project and will present it to the class. Perfect for young conservationists and aspiring zoologists!

### Student Requirements

1. Students must be currently enrolled in the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grades and/or be a 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade graduate of Zoo School BASIC (Kindergarten Zoo School BASIC graduates will have to wait one more year).
2. Students must be 6 years old or older and be able to do 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade level work; **basic block printing and writing skills are essential.**
3. Students must be able to sit quietly, unattended, for 45 minutes. Special needs students are welcome; approval should be obtained from the instructor prior to enrollment.
4. Students are asked to bring a pencil bag/box, with writing pencils and colored pencils, to each class.

### Tuition

Zoo School BASIC tuition is \$120 per student, plus a \$20 materials fee; **total fee is \$140 per student.** Class size is limited, so register immediately to guarantee a space for your student. Payment-in-full is required for registration.
